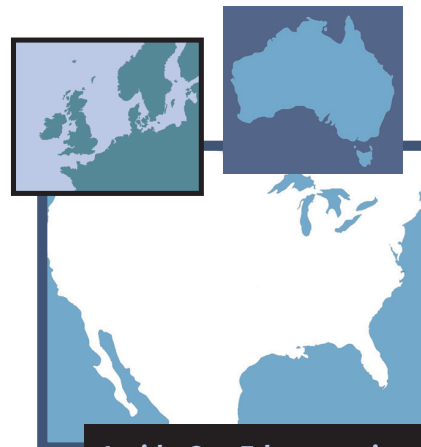
Over 200
